





# HOUSING OPTIONS AT UVIC



## ON CAMPUS HOUSING

On-campus housing is not guaranteed, and it is by lottery system. There are options for dormitories (with meal plans) to cluster or pod housing (with no meal plans). The range can be as high as \$2,046 CAD or ¥10,456/month for a dorm with meal plan to as low as \$1,207 CAD or ¥6,168/month for cluster/pod housing.



## OFF CAMPUS HOUSING


Renting an apartment, basement suite or condo can range from \$950 CAD or ¥4,855 to \$2,000 CAD or ¥10,221/month.

Price varies with location, type of housing, etc.




## What is the UVic-ECNU Dual Degree Program?



- ❖ Required to do 3 co-op terms, can challenge the 1<sup>st</sup> one
  - You can work in Canada or overseas
  - Average monthly salary is \$3,425 CAD or ¥17,499. This does vary depending on type of job and location.
  - First co-op position is typically a junior/entry-level position and will typically increase in level as students gain work experience.





# REQUIREMENTS

## 1. ECNU Required courses prior to entry: 商科必修课程

Dual Degree Required Course Subjects	ECNU Course Equivalent	ECNU Credits	Notes
Microeconomics	Microeconomics	3 credits	
Statistics	Probability Theory and Statistics	3 credits	
Mathematics	Advanced Mathematics	3 credits	

**OVERALL GPA:** For students transferring from a university/college the UVic admissions is looking for a minimum “B” GPA

**REQUIRED COURSES:** For the ECNU courses equivalent to UVic Microeconomics, Statistics, Math the GPA of those required courses should be an overall “B” where the lowest letter grade in a required course can be a “C+” but nothing lower.

**NOTE:** Due to competitiveness of the program, meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee entry.

# REQUIREMENTS

## 2. English language proficiency requirement:

**\*\*NOTE: Only current exam marks (within 2 years before application) are accepted**

- IELTS: 6.5 with no section less than 6.0

**OR**

- TOEFL: 90 (iBT) with no band less than 20

*Conditional Acceptance* is offered to students who have IELTS 6.0 (each section 5.5) or TOEFL 79 (each section 17). During the conditional period, you will have an opportunity to re-submit another test score. If your new test score does not meet the requirement then there is an opportunity to take a 4-week UAP "University Admissions Preparation and Canadian Studies" course in-person at UVic in July/August to fulfill the UVic English Language Requirement.

# APPLICATION MATERIALS

There are **3 parts** to the Dual Degree Application:

**1. Application Form**

- Completed on *Education Planner BC (EPBC)* online platform

**2. Official Transcripts from your Home University**

**3. English Proficiency Scores (IELTS/TOEFL)**

- Have your English Test Centre send it directly to "*University of Victoria – Undergraduate Admissions*"

# HOW TO APPLY

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: January 31<sup>st</sup>**

**1. Application Form:**

Go to the **Education Planner BC (EPBC) Website** (<https://apply.educationplannerbc.ca/>) and fill in the Application Form. Please look at the "EPBC Instruction Guide" to help you fill out the Application Form. After submission, please notify our office that you have applied to the Dual Degree program [GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca](mailto:GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca).

**2. English Proficiency Score:**

Have your English Test Centre send your TOEFL or IELTS exam results **directly** to UVic. Ask your English Test Centre to send it to "**University of Victoria - Undergraduate Admissions**". After official submission, please send a copy or screenshot to [GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca](mailto:GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca) for our reference.

**3. Official Transcripts:**

Have your digital Official Transcripts sent by your Home University Coordinator directly to: [adms5@uvic.ca](mailto:adms5@uvic.ca) & [bcomad@uvic.ca](mailto:bcomad@uvic.ca) & [GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca](mailto:GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca).

**4. List of Remaining Courses:** If your Spring/Summer courses are not reflected on your transcript, please send a word document with spring/summer course list to [GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca](mailto:GSBIntlAsctDir@uvic.ca).
